<p>Q1</p>	<p>Here is a list of music-making fields from which you should select the one or ones which you will teach.</p> <p>You will be required to show your level of competence in every field you list. Where formal courses and/or qualifications in that music-making field are offered by a recognized authority you should indicate the highest course and/or qualification you have obtained and the authority. You will need to attach evidence of your qualification to your application form (a scan will do – please scan as pdf and make sure it is black and white and resolution no greater than 300 dpi). Please include a transcript.</p> <p>If there are no internationally recognized qualifications in your music-making field or fields, please give the name(s) of expert teachers with whom you have studied</p>
Q3	<p>In order to become a full Associate Member, you must be able to show you are a musical performer at the level of, for example, ATCL, DipABRSM, AMusNZ or 200-level performance at a University (NZQA Level 6 or above), and be able to teach from beginners to higher grades, or have completed the IRMT Foundation Course. You have two years (with negotiable extension to three years if circumstances require) to complete these requirements</p> <p>If there are no internationally recognized qualifications in your music-making field or fields, please give the name(s) of expert teachers with whom you have studied</p>
Q4 and Q5	<p>You do not have to have any teaching qualifications to be admitted as a Provisional Member. If you do, you will need to attach evidence of your qualification (including a transcript) to your application form (a scan will do). If you don't, you will be provided with a mentor who will support you through enrolment in our Foundation Course. Alternatively, you can study for ATCL (Teaching) or DipABRSM (Teaching) or another course that can be accepted by the IRMT Registration Board as equivalent.</p>
Q6	<p>Examples might be Training as a Registered Classroom Teacher, or a qualification obtained overseas</p>
Q7	<p>If you enrol in our Foundation Course we will try to help you work with these students</p>
Police Check	<p>All Registered Members of the IRMT are required to obtain a Ministry of Justice Request for Criminal Conviction History – this form is available from the IRMTNZ website https://www.learnmusicnz.org.nz/membership/ for you to complete. <u>This is your responsibility.</u> The IRMTNZ Code of Ethics and Student Safety Policy can be found on this website.</p>
