



DISTINGUISHED BRANCH MEMBER (DBM) NOMINATION FORM

Branches should consider the following criteria as a guideline in nominating a member for the award of Distinguished Branch Member:

- Length of membership of IRMTNZ
- Distinguished service to IRMTNZ and services to music teaching at a local level.
- Attendances at local IRMTNZ activities e.g. local seminars and masterclasses and recitals
- Significant contribution to the IRMTNZ at a local level and/or a significant contribution to the general musical life of the local community.
- Significant assistance given to younger and/or less experienced music teachers.
- Significant contribution to music education.

This form is for nomination of a member for consideration as a Distinguished Branch Member (DBM) of the IRMTNZ. The nominators will need to provide a citation of not more than 500 words for the candidate being considered.
