ONLINE CPD INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Members,

Online CPD is here as of 1 December 2019! We have the videos of presentations from the 2019 Conference in Dunedin available online for members to view, as well as the videos of the Marvin Blickenstaff seminar. This is an exciting new development so that those of you who missed out on the conferences can have the same great learning opportunities the rest of us enjoyed.

The online CPD videos are being hosted by CLAD Services. In order to access these videos you need to do the following:

- Go to the CLAD OnlineCPD website link <https://www.onlinecpd.co.nz/course-providers/institute-of-registered-music-teachers/>
- You will see the available courses you can choose. There is NO CHARGE to members to view each video – however you will need to be confirmed as a paid-up member before you are able to access the course.
- You will need to create an account, and you can then enrol for the course(s) you wish to review. You will need to follow the instructions to enrol.
- Once we have confirmed that you are a paid-up member of the IRMTNZ, you will be sent an email with access to the course
- Make sure you complete the viewing and get your Completion Certificate as evidence that you have undertaken the CPD (you will get **25 CPD points** for each course completed).

The videos will be available online up to the end of the year (depending on the agreement made with the presenters) - so act now while you can. These are excellent presentations which will add value to your teaching work. And Council has agreed that you gain **25 CPD points** for each completed CPD video, a great boost to your annual score!

Remember that you will need to get your CPD report for the previous year to your Branch Secretary or designated alternative in early December.

New videos will be added as they come to hand, and the organizers of the Auckland conference are editing the highlights of that conference which should become available later in 2020.
